Concept: >My idea for the Simply Elemental: An Outdoor Art Adventure was to build a lotus flower sculpture for the center of the pond in the Hahn Horticulture Garden. I chose to create white lotus flower because it is a unifying symbol of hope across time, cultures and religions. The flower is 5' in diameter and constructed with sheer white fabric and wire. It is mounted on a float and anchored in the water. By making it larger than life, move with the wind, reflect in the pond and gently illuminated at night, I hope to create a sense of wonder for the viewer and the opportunity to consider the purity of mind and spirit that the lotus flower represents.
